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5 Student Health/Physical Screenings/Examinations

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7 The Board may arrange each year for health services to be provided to all students. Such services may
8 include but not be limited to:

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- 10 1. Development of procedures at each building for isolation and temporary care of students who
- 11 become ill during the school day.
- 12
- 13 2. Consulting services of a qualified specialist for staff, students, and parents.
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- 15 3. Vision and hearing screening.
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- 17 4. Scoliosis screening.
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- 19 5. Immunization as provided by the Department of Public Health and Human Services.
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21 Parents/guardians will receive written notice of any screening result which indicates a condition that
22 might interfere or tend to interfere with a student’s progress.

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24 In general, the District will not conduct physical examinations of a student without parental consent to do
25 so or by court order, unless the health or safety of the student or others is in question. Further, parents
26 will be notified of the specific or approximate dates during the school year when screening administered
27 by the District is conducted, which are:

- 28
- 29 1. Required as a condition of attendance.
- 30 2. Administered by the school and scheduled by the school in advance.
- 31 3. Not necessary to protect the immediate health and safety of the student or other students.

33 Parents or eligible students will be given the opportunity to opt out of the above-described.
